DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING	
OVERCALLS — General Style	10-17 (4)5+ cards
Responses	PRE raises, cue INV+raise, shift F1
IN BAL. POS.	Maybe light with short opening suit
Responses	as above
TAKE-OUT DOUBLE — General Style	10+ proper distribution or strong one-suiter
Responses	Limit bids, cue promises another bid
IN BAL. POS.	Obligatory with shortness in opponent's suit

1NT OVERCALL	Responses
2nd pos. 15-18	2♣ Stayman
4th pos. 11-14	2♣ Stayman
